

LGBTQIA+ History Month

Although LGBTQIA+ history should be remembered, marked and celebrated all year round, LGBT+ History Month provides an opportunity to learn, educate, raise awareness and give visibility to LGBTQIA+ communities past and present.

LGBT+ History Month was first celebrated in 2005, and founded by Schools Out UK who have spent the last 45 years campaigning for LGBT+ Inclusion in Schools. The aim of LGBT+ History Month is to increase the visibility of the histories, lives and experiences of LGBT+ people as well as promoting their wellbeing and inclusion and raising awareness of matters that affect LGBT+ communities.

With this collective exhibition we aim to highlight local Queer artists and hopefully form connections between artists and creatives highlighting the rich LGBTQIA+ culture here in Deptford and wider SE London.

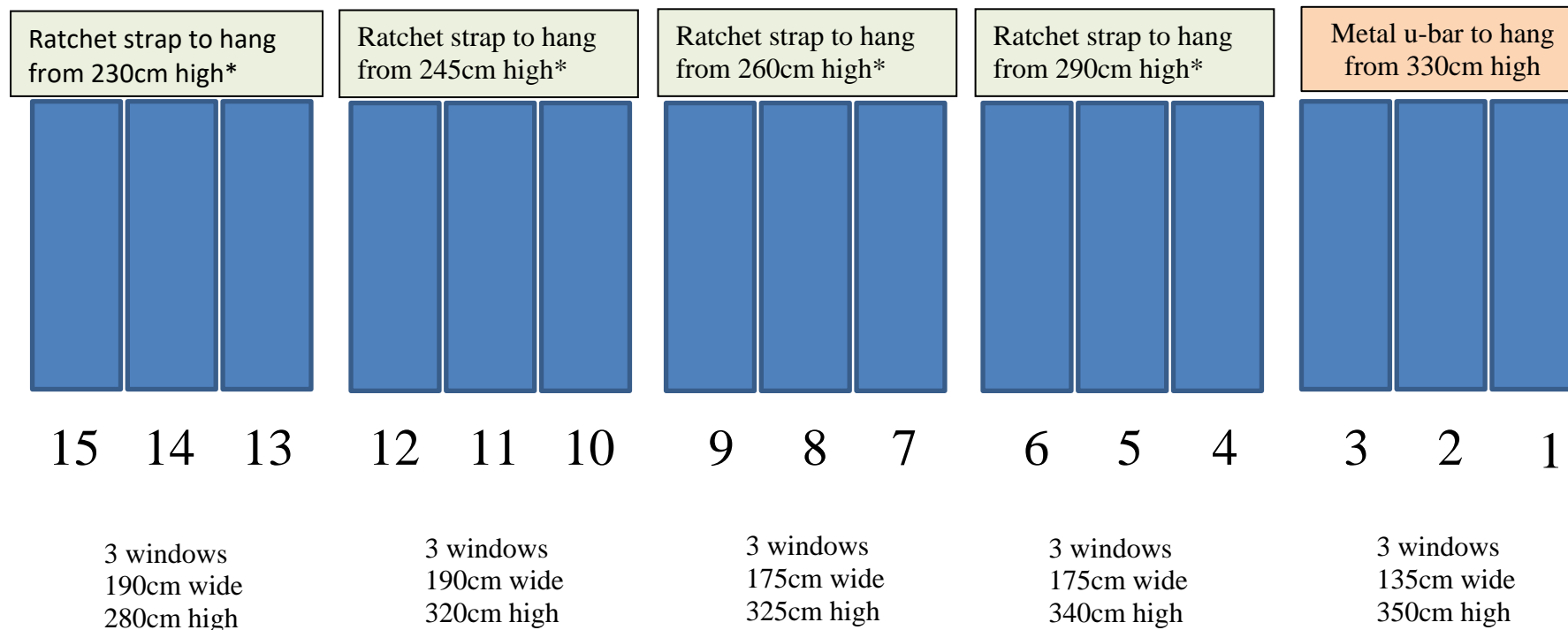
Displaying

Work will be displayed in the windows here at Deptford Lounge, along Giffin street. This means the work can be on display for 24hr a day. The library is open 9am-7pm Mon-Fri and 9am-5pm Sat. While the library is closed, we will light work using uplighters that can be set to many desired colours. We also have TV's and Speakers available to display audio-visual work.

Windows

The windows running along the Giffin Street side of the building can also be used to display art work



*Measurement is approx, but can be moved up and down by the artist if required

Windows 1-15 are suitable for a hanging display. The art work can be hung by fishing wire, artist wire or chain. The work could be made from foam board. Anything heavier than foam board would be better in windows 1-3 as there is a metal u-bar to hang from.

There is a further window on the front next to the accessible door, facing Giffin square. This 168cm wide x 228cm tall. The windows facing Giffin Square on the corner can also be used however the bike racks do obscure most of the window so not ideal.

Uplighters



Eight BBP54 battery uplighters, Each of the BBP54 LED wireless uplighters in this set has four 12W LEDs that create an incredibly bright output, lighting surfaces effectively in both light and dark conditions. These will be used at night to illuminate artwork from below.

TV



A free standing Samsung UE46D5000 46" widescreen LCD screen, to show a film, short, animation etc is also available. Load your AV onto a USB in a MP4 format and this can then be screen on a continuous loop.
